

Helping Young Adults Find Employment

The United Neighborhood Centers of Milwaukee's Home office works with Milwaukee's underserved youth and young adults through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title 1B Out of School Youth (OSY) program to help them finish high school and secure training and credentials in order to proceed on a path to sustainable employment. Our skilled professionals direct these youth through a variety of career options including the medical, early childhood, hospitality and construction fields. In 2020 we worked with 225 participants in the program. Of those 225, we helped 153 obtain employment by year end.
